Called to Order

- ✓ From the Wildwood Park District budget we were given \$3,500

- ✓ Nick Gowe has not responded to calls, and both Nick Gowe and Mike Perkaus have similar prices for treatments.
- ✓ The next step is to have the board officially approve Mike Perkaus' plan.
- ✓ The challenge is to fund Mike's plan, hopefully admissions will go up, but we need to get creative with donations and fundraisers.

  - We will be asking the boy scouts to help us and perhaps give them a donation in return. Also we will ask FBLA for volunteers.
- ✓ To help promote awareness about the lake and our group we are going to start a newsletter, and Randy Mundinger will facilitate this. The whole committee will help deliver them to residents around the lake and just across the street from the lake.
