

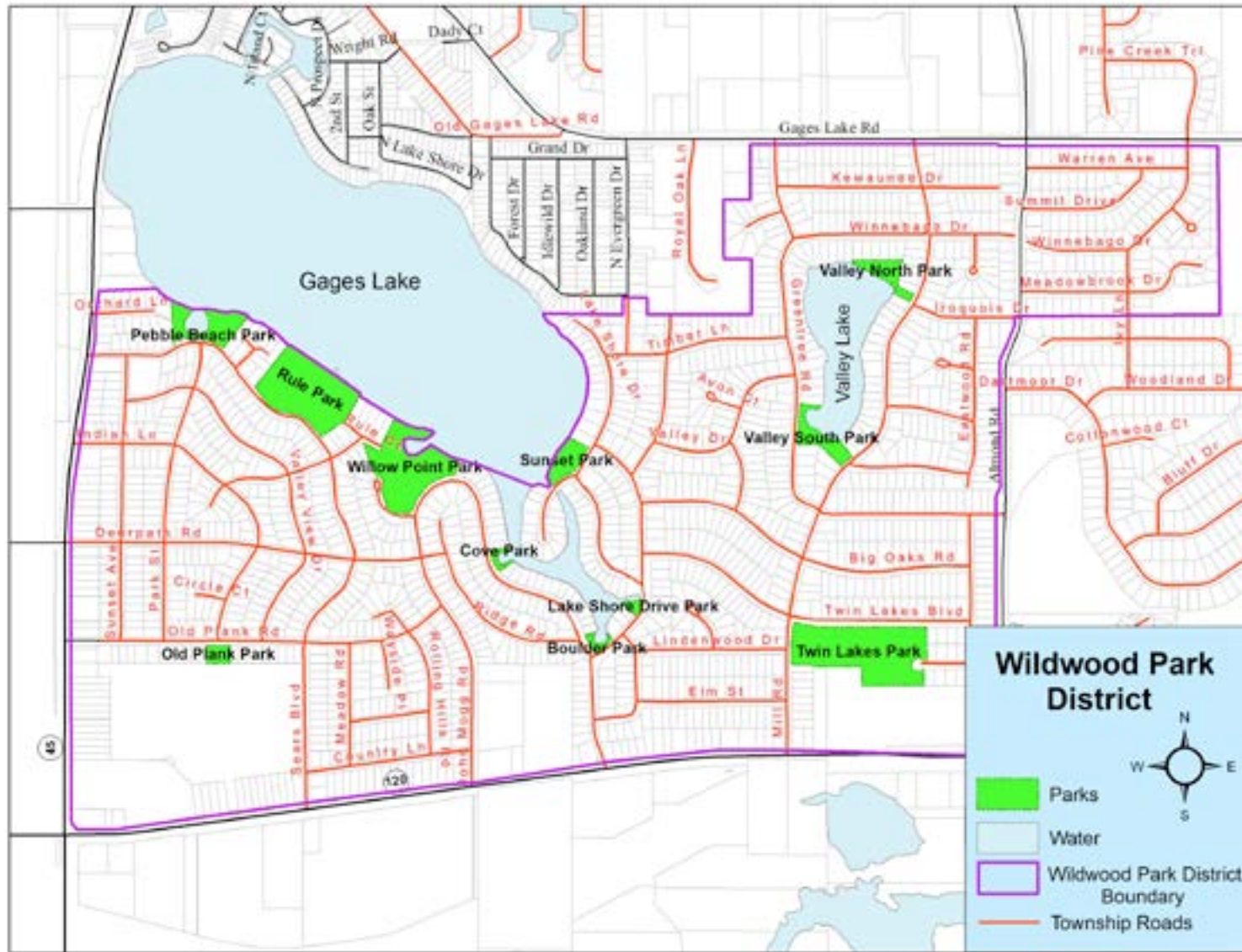

We offer various options for your registration needs:

Online: Register online at www.WildwoodParkDistrict.com.

Mail: Complete a registration form found in this brochure and mail it to the Wildwood Park District office. Credit card or check accepted.

Fax: Fax completed registration form and credit card payment information to 847-223-2820.

In Person: Drop off registration form at our office during office hours. Cash, credit cards and checks accepted.

Mail Slot: On the South side of the Rule House Building there is a mail slot on the door. Registration can be dropped off through this mail slot during non-office hours.

Checks should be made payable to Wildwood Park District. Note: Any check that is deposited and returned by the bank for any reason will result in an additional \$36 charge. All registration receipts will be sent via email. If you require a hard copy receipt, please let us know and one will be mailed to you.

Registration Deadline

Registration ends one week prior to the beginning of each program or event unless otherwise noted. It is recommended you sign up for each program or special event as soon as possible to secure your spot.

Refund Policy

General program fee refunds, less a service charge of 20% (not to exceed \$10), will be made if a request is received at least seven days before the start of the program. After that time, refunds can only be given for medical reasons. Note: Refunds cannot be given for programs or trips that require advance admission or entrance fees. If Wildwood Park District needs to reschedule or cancel programs due to insufficient registration, full refunds will be provided.

Dogs in the Parks

Dogs are welcome in the Wildwood Park District parks. Please be reminded that dogs must always be on a leash and owners must clean up after their dogs.

Behavior Code of Conduct

The following behavior code of conduct will be used as a guideline for Wildwood Park District program participants.

Participants will:

- Show respect to all other participants, staff, and volunteers.
- Follow direction from staff and volunteers.
- Show respect to equipment, supplies, and facilities.
- Not use inappropriate, abusive, or foul language.
- Not show any aggressive behavior (hitting, punching, slapping, kicking, biting, etc.)
- Not show continuous disruptive behavior.
- Obey all Wildwood Park District rules and regulations for specific programs.

Minimum & Maximum

In order to secure supplies, all programs require a minimum number of participants to have registered seven days before the class begins. A maximum number is also listed to ensure quality instruction. Wildwood Park District reserves the right to adjust the min/max numbers on programs/events when deemed necessary. Classes may be combined and times modified to facilitate better programs.

Resident Parking Permits

New parking permits for 2018 are now available. The parking permits are only available to Wildwood Park District residents. Parking permits are free if residents come in to the Park District office or \$5.00 if purchased online. You must present current vehicle registrations for all vehicles that are registered to your address to receive your permits. Please bring this information to our office or if purchasing online, please mail to 33325 N. Sears Blvd., Wildwood, IL 60030, fax to 847-223-2820, or scan and email the information to info@wildwoodparkdistrict.com. For online purchases, the permit will be mailed once the vehicle registration is received.

Boat Ramp Keys

Annual boat keys for 2018 will go on sale April 2nd. Boat ramp keys open the launches at Pebble Beach and Sunset Parks. To purchase a boat ramp key, you must present a current DNR boat registration for each of the boats/water crafts that are listed in the resident's name and Wildwood address. Along with your boat ramp key, you will receive one boat decal. You may purchase additional decals for \$10.00 each. You will need a decal for any motorized water crafts. Boat ramp keys are \$100.00 and \$75.00 for seniors 65+.

Wildwood Park District's Schoolhouse Adventures Community Preschool welcomes children 3-5 years old to our wonderful program. TOT CAMP

The Tot Camp program provides children who have not yet been to kindergarten a chance to engage in activities and build social skills throughout the summer. Tot Camp is designed to provide your little one with physical, mental, and social activities. Tots will get creative with themed arts and crafts, free choice indoor and outdoor play, music and stories. Children will have a blast going on nature walks, playing games outside, and being active with friends on our age-appropriate playground. We encourage children to bring their own water bottles, while the Park District will provide a snack each day. Children must be potty-trained. Participants should bring a swimsuit and towel on Tuesdays for water activities, which include sprinklers, water tables, sponges and more.

Details

Camp Attire: Please send your camper with a water bottle and dressed for play. Consider sending an extra set of clothes in case of an accident. On cooler days, please send a sweatshirt or jacket. On Tuesdays, be sure your child has a towel and a swimsuit. It is important to label every item brought or worn to camp. Check the lost and found box if something is left behind.

Sunscreen/Bug Repellent: Please apply sunscreen and bug repellent to your camper each day. You may also send your child with a labeled bottle of sunscreen for applications during the day.

Snacks/Drinks: One snack will be provided each day of camp. We will have water available at all times, but we suggest bringing your own water bottle each day.

Check In/Out: Tot Camp check in will be located inside our program entrance on the west side of the building. Campers must be checked in and out each day. Drop off begins at 9:00am and pick up is at 12:00pm. Children must be picked up by 12:00pm, or a \$1.00 late fee per minute per child will be applied. Children will be all around the park, so please use caution when entering and exiting our parking lot.

Allergies/Medication: Please note on your Camper Information Form if your camper has any allergies or medications they need to take at camp. If necessary, we will provide an additional form for you to fill out.

Staff Training: Tot Camp staff go through many hours of training, including CPR, First Aid, behavior management, safety and activity planning, specifically for this age group.

Registration

Three 3-week sessions are available for Camp Rules!. Registration for the first session will not guarantee your child a spot for the second and third sessions. You must register by the Wednesday before each session begins.

Children can be registered for camp 5 days a week or 3 days a week. If you opt for 3 days a week, you will be asked to pick 3 days of the week when you register. These days will be the same throughout the session.

Deposits can be made to hold your spot in a session and will be applied toward full payment. Deposit per session is \$50.00 and is non-refundable. Full payment must be made by the Wednesday before the session begins. If full payment is not received by this time, the deposit will be forfeited.

Registration may be done in person, online, by mail or fax. Deposits cannot be made online.

A Camp Handbook will be given or emailed to you at the time of registration. It will also be available online at www.wildwoodparkdistrict.com. This handbook contains information you need to know before sending your child to camp.

The total fee per session includes 3 weeks of camp and field trips.
