Recently completed projects include Pebble Beach Park fishing pier replacement in October, both Sunset and Willow Point Park Pavilions underwent major restoration work this fall, as well as permanent rock bike racks in several parks. Stormwater and drainage improvements around Valley Lake began this summer and will continue into winter/ spring as part of the Stormwater Infrastructure Improvements Project, led by Lake County Stormwater Management. ## General Information

#### **BOAT RAMP KEYS**

Annual boat ramp keys for 2024-2025 will go on sale April 1st, 2024. These new keys will be able to open the boat launches beginning on and after May 1. Boat ramp keys open the launches at Pebble Beach and Sunset Park. To purchase a key, residents must present a current DNR boat registration for each boat/water craft that are listed in the resident's name, and Wildwood address. Along with your boat ramp key, you will receive one boat decal. You may purchase additional decals for \$10.00 each. Decals are required for any motorized water craft. Boat ramp keys are \$100.00, or \$75.00 for seniors 65+ and current/former military personnel.

Friendly dogs are welcome in the Wildwood Park District parks. Please be reminded that dogs must always be leashed and owners must clean up after their dogs. Dog Mutt Mitts are available in most parks.




