A Word from the Park District Manager

Dear Wildwood Residents.

s the weather warms and the sun sets later in the evenings, there is nothing quite like summer in AWildwood. Our community comes to life with children playing in the parks, residents strolling our walking paths, beach goers cooling off in one of our two refreshing lakes, and boaters taking to the Gages Lake and Valley Lake waters. This, coupled with the Wildwood Park District's exciting summertime events and programs, create a lively yet laid-back atmosphere that almost makes Wildwood feel like a vacation town. As we enter this delightful time of year, I am excited to share with you all the new and exciting events, programs, news, and projects we have planned to make this a fun summer for all in Wildwood!



Our Maintenance Team continues to strive for excellence in maintaining our greenspaces, facilities, and playgrounds for our residents. Several new spring and summer initiatives include continued in-house restoration of sitting benches, replacement of split-rail fence at Twin Lakes Park, addition of accessible crushed stone walkway ramp into Sunset Park, restoration of Willow Point and Twin Lakes Parks baseball backstops, and a multitude of restorative painting, power washing, and wood replacement projects throughout the parks. Attention will always be focused on maintaining safe, usable, and high-quality parks for our residents.

Pebble Beach Park shoreline enhancement planning and protection progress continues. Stormwater and drainage improvements around Valley Lake, which began last fall as part of the Stormwater Infrastructure Improvements Project - led by Lake County Stormwater Management - are nearing completion. We look forward to improved water quality in Valley Lake as well as reduction of significant flooding risk. Consideration has been taken into the quality of fishery at Valley Lake; with efforts being made to begin a re-stocking program for Summer 2024. All past, current, and upcoming capital projects and improvements can be found on our website at www.wildwoodparkdistrict.com/capital-projects-planning/.

The Wildwood Park District is proud to partner with the Gages Lake Conservation Committee (GLCC) to assess and help manage the health and treatment of Gages Lake. We encourage the community to attend GLCC meetings and share your feedback on topics varying from lily pad and aquatic weed treatment, fish stocking, and shoreline cleanup. In 2024, the GLCC rolled out a brand-new web page, social media presence, and contact information to have a stronger connection with the community. All GLCC information, meeting dates, agendas, minutes, and how to get involved can be found here: www.wildwoodparkdistrict.com/gages-lake-conservation-committee/.

Safe and orderly parks and greenspaces continue to be a priority of the Wildwood Park District. We are proud to continue seeking greater cooperation with the Lake County Sherriff's Department and their auxiliaries for their presence at the parks, along with our in-house Park Safety and Boat Ramp Monitor Staff. Current initiatives are underway to add additional security lighting to the parks in time for the summer. As part of our continuous improvement strategy, we recently conducted a Community Needs Assessment Survey to help identify the communities needs and interests. Over 130 Wildwood residents completed the survey, providing the Park District with invaluable feedback. We are proud to say that we have already turned this feedback into action by adding additional information and resources to our website, expanding programs and events, and improving upon safety initiatives and procedures. Survey findings will be made available to the public in a report on our website once complete.

Finally, we here at the Wildwood Park District pride ourselves on providing diverse programs, events, and activities for all ages within our community. On behalf of the entire Wildwood Park District Team, we want to extend our most heartfelt gratitude to our community members for continuing to support us for all of your park and recreation needs.

We are truly honored to serve you. I look forward to sharing another memorable summer with all of you.

BOAT RAMP KEYS

Annual boat ramp keys for 2024 - 2025 go on sale April 1st. Boat ramp keys open the launches at Pebble Beach and Sunset Park. To purchase a key, residents must present a current DNR boat registration for each boat/ water craft that are listed in the resident's name, and Wildwood address. Along with your boat ramp key, you will receive one boat decal. You may purchase additional decals for \$10.00 each. Decals are required for any motorized water craft. Boat ramp keys are \$100.00, or \$75.00 for seniors 65+ and current/former military personnel.

Friendly dogs are welcome in the Wildwood Park District parks. Please be reminded that dogs must always be leashed and controlled by their owner, and owners must clean up after their dogs. Dog Mutt Mitt dispensers are available in most parks.
